

Membership Fee Policy

Member Category	Description	Fees per Year
Minerals Companies	Including those companies involved in the Saskatchewan minerals industry in exploration, development, extraction/production or closure/reclamation, and share a commitment to innovation through IMII. Company fees are assessed according to the following categories:	
Category A	Companies with annual international revenues exceeding \$100M US	\$100,000
Category B	Companies with annual international revenues between \$20M to \$100M US	\$25,000
Category C	Companies with annual international revenues less than \$20M US	\$5,000
Supply Chain Companies	Those companies who are not minerals producers but are involved in the mineral industry's innovation ecosystem through the provision of goods and service, including original equipment manufacturers, engineering firms, construction companies, consultancies, other service companies. Company fees are assessed according to the following categories:	
Category A	Large supply chain companies with international revenues of more than \$20 million US	\$25,000
Category B	Mid-size supply chain companies with international revenues of more than \$1 million but less than \$20 million US	\$5,000
Category C	Small supply chain companies with international revenues of less than \$1 million US	\$2,500
Government Entities	Government agencies and departments which share a commitment to innovation through IMII, and support financially or otherwise the activities of IMII to a degree satisfactory to the Board.	Changes year to year
Institutions	Non-for-profit post secondary education and research organizations in Saskatchewan that share the mineral companies' commitment to innovation through IMII, and may contribute to E&T and R&D activities of IMII to a degree satisfactory to the Board	\$0
Associates	Not-for-profit organizations that represent interests relevant to the minerals industry to a degree satisfactory to the Board	\$0
